standardized tests are also administered to better understand the nature of your typical workday. The length of the FCE depends on the complexity of the illness or injury, and the availability of clearly-defined physical demands.

#### Portable Defibrillators Awarded

The Village of Ellenville Police Department and the Ulster County Sheriff's Department received automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) as a result of a New York State Office of Rural Health grant. Mid-Hudson Family Health Institute (Institute), operator of the Family Practice Centers of Ellenville, Kingston, New Paltz, Port Ewen, New Windsor, and Hyde Park, was awarded this \$4,000 grant for the purpose of placing AED units in locations accessible to first responders in rural areas. The Institute worked with Police Chief Philip Mattracion of the *Village of Ellenville Police Department* and First Sergeant Vincent Altier of the *Ulster County Sheriff's Department* to place three units in department vehicles.

Traditionally, the ability to defibrillate was solely in the hands of emergency medical personnel. AEDs are a new generation of defibrillators that allow trained lay rescuers to deliver an electronic shock for a cardiac arrest. The new AEDs are safe, effective, lightweight, low-maintenance and easy to use, and have improved survival rates for cardiac arrest victims in remote locations when

quick EMS response isn't always possible.

"Often, law enforcement personnel are the first on the scene of an accident or rescue call. Having these (AED) units in our vehicles could be the difference between life or death," stated Chief Mattracion (below, white shirt, with, from left, Ellenville Village Manager Elliott Auerbach, Village Trustee and EFA&RS volunteer John Gavaris, and Ms. Hornbeck). "We have had a long-



standing relationship with the Family Practice Center of Ellenville and are grateful the Institute chose our department to receive one of these units."

Mid-Hudson Family Health Institute is a not-for-profit
