Vendor setup is no earlier than 7:00 a.m., with no breakdowns prior to 4 p.m. All vendors must be in place and all vehicles removed to proper parking areas by 8:30 a.m. The EWCoC and festival committee reserve the right to refuse or reject any vendor/exhibitor – no reason need be given. **Booth Fees:** Please note all booth fees are non-refundable.

Non-profit organizations are charged <u>no fee,</u> but must submit a registration form no later than August 15, 2005

All others:

\$35.00 per space *if payment is* <u>received by</u> August 1, 2005 \$50.00 per space *if payment is received after* August 1, 2005
